

**RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT THE 29TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING
OF THE JAMAICAN BAR ASSOCIATION HELD ON MAY 9, 2009
AT THE INSTITUTE OF JAMAICA, KING STREET, KINGSTON**

1. RESOLVED that the Association calls upon the government of Jamaica and the other treaty states to address the outstanding obstacles to Jamaica's participation in the Caribbean Court of Justice at the appellate level; to take appropriate steps to increase the insulation of the court from political interference to make the court more accessible as regards cost and jurisdiction and in particular to entrench the Caribbean Court of Justice on the basis of the recommendations of the Jamaican Bar Association and the decision of our highest Appellate Court.
2. RESOLVED that the Association adopts the Articles of Incorporation presented at the meeting with all amendments made thereto in place of the existing Articles of Association.
3. RESOLVED that the Association requests that the term of office of members of the Disciplinary Committee of the General Council be limited to a maximum of three terms of office of three years with no more than two consecutive terms.
