RESOLUTION

WE, the members of the Jamaican Bar Association having considered in General Meeting the issue of joint membership by elected members of the Bar Council of the Jamaican Bar Association also holding office as members of the General Legal council and/or the Disciplinary Committee of the General legal Council;

AND having concluded that the holding of such joint offices is inappropriate for the proper disposition of the duties of members of the Council of the Jamaican Bar Association and creates a potential conflict of interest between the desires of members of the Jamaican bar Association and the wishes and dictates of the General legal Council and/or its Disciplinary Committee;

WE HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

That clause 15 of the Articles of Association of the Jamaican Bar Association be amended by adding the following:

- (f) No member of the General Legal Council, the Disciplinary Committee of the General Legal Council, or any body charged by statute or law with regulating the conduct and practice of Attorneys-at-Law, shall be eligible for election to any position in the Council. Members of Council who become ineligible by virtue of this provision shall continue to hold office until they shall next retire in accordance with these Articles.
