**1. NEW LEGISLATION**: The Bar has received the following Bill from the Houses of Parliament (Gordon House):

An Act to enhance revenue administration and collection by granting an amnesty, for a period of six months or such further period as each House of Parliament may determine by resolution, to facilitate the payment of outstanding penalties relating to prescribed notices issued on or before September 20, 2010 pursuant to section 116(2) of the Road Traffic Act; and for connected matters. (Act No. 1/12)

An Act to Amend the Processed Food Act (Act No. 2/12)

An Act to Amend the Standards Act (Act No. 3/12)

An Act to Amend the Telecommunications Act (Act No. 4/12)
